O & A About School Fees

What are fees for?

School fees support the cost of operation for the school, whether for supplies for the students in the classroom or the cost of postage for report cards. The variety of itemized fees gives students and parents an idea of where the money goes.

Are DaVinci fees higher than other schools?

DaVinci has tried to set its fees comparable to schools in the Ogden, Weber, and Davis school districts.

What is the transportation fee?

DaVinci is using UTA for all its field trips and for bussing to and from school with the commercial UTA busses along the regular UTA routes. UTA has agreed to provide full student commuter passes for the entire year for one low price. Students will be able to use their passes anytime, on any UTA line including light rail and the commuter busses.

What are the class fees for?

Class fees in music classes will be used to purchase music-since we are brand new, we don't have a music library yet. They may also be used to purchase or repair equipment for classes. Fees for science will purchase chemicals or other materials for student use in the classroom. Any fees for a specific class are spent to purchase materials for that class.

What are club fees for?

Club fees will pay for advisors for the club and club supplies. Clubs are not mandatory, so fees for clubs cannot be waived. The final fee for each club will be determined after the clubs are established, so we will not collect the fee now.

Will there be more fees later on?

If you are planning to participate in club, there will be a fee. If you participate in a class, art, for example, you might have an expense for materials that will be your own property afterwards, a canvas for painting perhaps. You will not be charged more for other classes, like science.

If we pay all these fees, do we still have supplies to buy for classes?

The class fees do not cover paper, pens, or the basic materials necessary for class. We have prepared a list of supplies for the classes which includes paper, binders, notebooks, colored pencils, etc. These supplies are the student's responsibility.

What about the donations listed on the teacher supply sheets?

Donations are simply that, donations. If it is not a hardship or an inconvenience and you wish to donate to the school, we would be happy to accept. Donations are not required and you cannot be penalized for not donating.

Do you accept fee waivers?

We accept fee waivers from any eligible student. Students in state custody, students receiving public assistance in the form of Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC), or Supplemental Security Income (applies to the child receiving SSI), or students who are eligible for free lunch. Partial or complete fee waivers may also be granted in the event of severe financial hardship. Documentation of eligibility for a waiver is required.

Will my application for a fee waiver be kept confidential?

Absolutely! DaVinci respects the privacy of every family and student.

Can a fee for a remedial class be waived?

No. Remedial classes have a fee that cannot be waived.

Are fees for early college or concurrent enrollment classes waived for eligible students?

No. Since college classes, even early ones, are post secondary education, fee waivers cannot apply. Fees may differ for the variety of concurrent enrollment classes we offer. Textbooks of college credit classes are ALWAYS the student's responsibility.

Are school fees refunded if I leave DaVinci?

There is no entitlement to a refund for school fees.
